The book contains 336 pages, 145 figures (25 in colour), is available in two forms: ISBN 978-3-642-33317-0 e-book as PDF or EPUB (107,09 €) and ISBN 978-3-642-33316-3 hardbound book (129,99 €). The title page, preface, book contents and a book section can be downloaded from URL 5. In order to attract readers, a free preview is available for both books in which some pages are omitted.

CAERT-THRESOOR

Nizozemski časopis o povijesti kartografije *Caert-Thresoor* izlazi četiri puta godišnje. Časopis je na nizozeskom jeziku, sa sažecima na engleskom jeziku. Dostupan je osim u tiskanom obliku i na mrežnim stranicama <http://www.caert-thresoor.nl/english.html> (URL 1) u digitalnom obliku (PDF), do broja 3 u 2010. godini. Dvojezične alternativno nizozemsko-engleske internetske stranice su lijepo i jasno oblikovane sa svim važnim podacima o časopisu: *Caert-Thresoor* izdaje Fundacija Barent Langenes i jedini je nizozemski časopiskoj je posvećen dostignućima povijesti kartografije. Objavljeni radovi bave se različitim aspektima povijesti kartografije, kao što su planovi gradova, utvrda i vrtova, razvoj dekoracija po stilovima te aktivnostima pojedinih karto-

graфа, gravera i izdavača. Časopis obrađuje i nizozemske zbirke karata i najavljuje otkrića neobičnih primjeraka karata. Čitatelji *Caert-Thresoora* redovito se obavještavaju o novoj literaturi, faksimilima i izložbama. Časopis je prvi puta objavljen 1982., a izlazi 4 puta na godinu. Ima oko 650 preplatnika, uglavnom iz Nizozemske. Općenito, svaki svežak sadrži dva ili tri članka, prikaze, novosti i najave ('*Variia Cartographica*') i popis nove literature i faksimila. Jezik objavljivanja je nizozemski, a sažeci su na engleskom jeziku.

Caert-Thresoor is a Dutch journal about the history of cartography which has been published four times a year since 1982. The journal is in Dutch, with abstract in English. It is available in printed and digital

form (PDF) up to volume 3 in 2010 (URL1). The Dutch-English journal website is nice and clearly designed with all important data about the journal: *Caert-Thresoor* published by the Barent Langenes Foundation is the only journal published in the Netherlands devoted to the history of cartography. The articles concern various aspects of historical cartography, such as plans of towns, fortifications and gardens, developments in styles of decoration and activities of individual mapmakers, engravers and publishers. The journal also features contributions on Dutch map collections and announcements of findings of unusual items. Readers of *Caert-Thresoor* are frequently informed about new literature, facsimiles and exhibitions. First published in 1982, *Caert-Thresoor* is

nowadays published four times a year. The journal has about 650 subscribers, mainly in the Netherlands. Generally, each issue contains two or three articles, reviews, news and announcements ('Varia Cartographica') and listings of new literature and facsimiles. The journal is published in Dutch, with English summaries.

Mrežne stranice samo na nizozemskom jeziku sadrže i: @ la Carte (@ la Carte 2000–2001, @ la Carte 2002–2004 i @ la Carte 2005–2010), internetske izvore o povijesti kartografije, *Map collections in the Netherlands* Kartografske zbirke u Nizozemskoj, *Register and Name index Caert-Thresoor* vol. 1–20, bibliografija brojeva od 1 do 20 (1982–2001), upute autorima i leksikon o nizozemskim kartografima 1500–1900.

Broj 32 iz 2013. na naslovniči prikazuje dio karte iz prvog rada objavljenoga u tom broju. Na unutrašnjoj stranici je sadržaj, osnovni podaci o časopisu: članovi redakcije, internetske stranice, tajnik, cijena, IBAN, adresa i kontakt podaci uprave ča-

sopisa i ISSN 0167 4994. Ovaj svezak im četiri lijepo ilustrirana rada:

The title page of issue no. 32 (2013) shows a part of the map from the first paper in the issue. The first page contains the table of contents, basic data about the journal: members of the editorial board, website, secretary, price, IBAN, address, journal management contact and ISSN 0167 4994. This volume contains four nicely illustrated papers:

Jan W. H. Werner: De eerste wandkaart van de Zeven Provinciën uit 1651: Als 'Stoel des Oorlogs' eruitgegeven bij Covens & Mortier omstreeks 1740, (*From the 'Atlas der Nederlands': the first wallmap of the Seven Provinces of 1651, re-issued as 'Stoel des Oorlogs'* by Covens & Mortier, c. 1740).

Minne Venema: De Deventer mappa mundi uit de twaalfde of dertiende eeuw (*The 12th/13th-century world map on the cover of a Sallustius manuscript in the Dutch town of Deventer*).

Marco van Egmond & Kees Smit: Kritiek op een zeventiende-eeuwse kaart van Romeins Nederland: Een onbekende brief van Buchelius aan de historicus Miraeus (*Criticism on a 17th-century historical map of the Roman Netherlands: an unknown letter by Buchelius to the historian Miraeus*).


Peter van der Krogt: Walcheren 1945: Een komische kaart van een overstroming (*Walcheren 1945: a comical map of a flood*).

Sadržaj drugog dijela časopisa: / The contents of the second part of the journal:

- *Varia* (različite kratke kartografske vesti, *Miscellaneous cartographic news*)

Časopis sadrži i dvije stranice nenačetljivo objavljenih oglasa.

The journal also contains two pages of unobtrusive advertisements.



Caert-Thresoor je zanimljiv časopis iz povijesti kartografije usmjerjen na nizozemsko tržište, cijeli tekstovi radova su na nizozemskom, sažeci radova i na engleskom jeziku. Gotovo svi svesci časopisa (do broja 3 iz 2010. godine) su na dvojezičnim nizozemsko-engleskim mrežnim stranicama (URL 1). Časopis je cjenovno dostupan (38€ za četiri sveska godišnje), a sadržajno zanimljiv i za širu čitalačku populaciju. Nizozemska ima dugu kartografsku tradiciju, što *Caert-Thresoor* preslikava svima nama.

Caert-Thresoor is an interesting history of cartography journal oriented toward the Dutch market, with full papers in Dutch and abstracts in English. Almost all issues can be found at the Dutch-English website (up to issue 3 in 2010, URL 1). The journal is not expensive (4 issues for 38€ yearly) and also interesting to wider reading audience. The Netherlands have a long cartographic tradition, as demonstrated by *Caert-Thresoor*.
