

19th Annual Assembly of the Croatian Cartographic Society

Zagreb, December 14, 2018



The 19th Annual Assembly of the Croatian Cartographic Society was held on 14 December 2018 in the Council Chamber of the Faculty of Architecture, Civil Engineering and Geodesy, Kačićeva 26, Zagreb. Prof. Dr. Damir Medak, Dean of the Faculty of Geodesy, welcomed those present on behalf of the host institute.

The Assembly was opened and chaired by Prof. Dr. Miljenko Lapaine, President of the Society. It was divided into three parts. The first, unofficial part, was a lecture by Prof. Dr. Robert Župan: *Impressions from China*.

Next, a quorum was confirmed according to Article 21 of the Statute, and the chairperson opened the official part of the Assembly by proposing the agenda:

The agenda was accepted unanimously. The minutes of the 18th Assembly were accepted unanimously. In his report on the work of the Society in 2018, the President said that regular sessions of the presidency had been held, and the annual Assembly had taken place in March 2018. The next Assembly will be held in early December 2019. He highlighted the following important events in 2018:

The Contract on Business and Technical Cooperation will be renewed regarding the work of informing the expert public of the activities of the State Geodetic Administration (DGU) via the journal *Cartography and Geoinformation*. There is a Contract on Sponsorship which obliges the Society to prepare and participate in the 29th International Cartography Conference and the 17th General Assembly of the ICA in Tokyo (15-20 July 2019) to acquaint the international cartographic community with the achievements of Croatian cartography. We participated in drafting the proposal for the new Act on the State Survey and Cadastre of Real Estate. According to the Act, the Society will provide one member of the Commission for the Standardisation of Geographic Names.

We applied on time for a tender by the Ministry of Science and Education for financial support for preparing and holding meetings, the work of a scientific-expert association, and for our journal and book.

A contract was signed with the Ministry for financial support for preparing and holding a scientific meeting in 2018. The amount was HRK 12,449.

A contract was signed with the Ministry for financial support for the work of a scientific-expert association in 2018. The amount was HRK 13,500.

A contract was signed with the Ministry for financial support for our scientific journal in 2018. The amount was HRK 62,340.

We have not yet signed a contract with the Ministry for financial support for publishing book. According to the results published on the Ministry website, we should be receiving HRK 17,783.

The Croatian Chamber of Chartered Geodesy Engineers has given us a one-off grant of HRK 7,000 for publishing the journal. A contract on an earmarked donation for the project "Public Access to the Collectio Felbar" has been signed (HRK 25,000).

19. godišnja skupština Hrvatskoga kartografskog društva

Devetnaesta godišnja skupština Hrvatskoga kartografskog društva (HKD) održana je 14. prosinca 2018. u Vijećnici AGG fakulteta, Kačićeva 26, u Zagrebu. Nazočne je u ime domaćina pozdravio prof. dr. sc. Damir Medak, dekan Geodetskog fakulteta.

Skupštinu, koja se sastojala od tri dijela, otvorio je i vodio prof. dr. sc. Miljenko Lapaine, predsjednik HKD-a. U prvom, neslužbenom dijelu održano je predavanje prof. dr. sc. Roberta Župana: *Dojmovi iz Kine*.

Nakon predavanja, utvrđeno je prema čl. 21 Statuta HKD-a da postoji kvorum te je predsjednik otvorio službeni dio godišnje skupštine prijedlogom dnevnoga reda:

Dnevni red prihvaćen je jednoglasno. Zapisnik s 18. redovite godišnje skupštine prihvaćen je jednoglasno. U svom izvještaju o radu HKD-a u 2018. godini predsjednik HKD-a izvjestio je da su održane redovite sjednice Predsjedništva, a u ožujku 2018. održana je redovita Godišnja skupština. Sljedeću Godišnju skupštinu planiramo početkom prosinca 2019. Od važnijih događanja u 2018. predsjednik je istaknuo sljedeće:

Bit će obnovljen Ugovor o poslovno-tehničkoj suradnji na poslovima informiranja stručne javnosti o aktivnostima Državne geodetske uprave (DGU) putem časopisa Kartografija i geoinformacije. Imamo i Ugovor o sponzorstvu kojim se HKD obvezuje da će obaviti pripreme i sudjelovati na 29. međunarodnoj kartografskoj konferenciji i 17. generalnoj skupštini ICA-e u Tokiju 15.–20. 7. 2019. te međunarodnu kartografsku zajednicu upoznati s dosezima hrvatske kartografije. Sudjelovali smo na izradi prijedloga novog Zakona o državnoj izmjeri i katastru nekretnina. Prema tom Zakonu, HKD će imati jednog člana u Povjerenstvu za standardizaciju geografskih imena.

Pravodobno smo se prijavili na natječaje Ministarstva znanosti i razvojovanja (MZD) za finansijsku potporu u pripremi i održavanju skupova, radu znanstvenostručne udruge, za potporu za časopis i za knjigu.



The journal *Cartography and Geoinformation* has been published regularly. Issues 28 and 29 were released and issue 30 is in preparation (January 2019). From issue 30, each article will have a DOI, thanks to the efforts of the editor-in-chief, Dr. Ana Kuveždić Divjak. We are aiming for the journal to be included in the Web of Science.

After Dr. Dražen Tutić left the Society, we looked for a new person to maintain our server. It was not easy,

as several people were interested, but did not take up the challenge. At the moment, we have a contract with Ivan Rožić.

The deadline for submitting abstracts to the International Cartographic Conference to be held in 2019 in Tokyo is 8 January 2019. A competition has been launched for children's drawing and this will be coordinated on behalf of the Society in Croatia by Dr. Ivka Kljajić. In the immediate future, we will apply to participate in the International Cartography Exhibition. Since the ICA General Assembly will be held in Tokyo, a national report must be compiled, and the Society will carry out the necessary activities for this.



5. Involve geodesy secondary schools

Projects:

1. Suggest scientific-expert projects which would advance Croatian cartography (e.g. The Future of Topographic Cartography).
2. Suggest to the relevant institutions that their cartographic and geoinformation products be reviewed and their quality confirmed.

1. Continually update and modernise the Society's website.
