

Miljenko Lapaine Awarded the International Cartographic Association Honorary Fellowship Recognition

The International Cartographic Association (ICA) awards the Honorary Fellowship recognition to internationally reputable cartographers who made significant contribution to ICA activities.

The 29th International Cartographic Conference and 18th ICA General Assembly were held in Tokyo from July 15 to 20, 2019. The ICA Honorary Fellowship recognitions were awarded to Evangelos Livieratos and Miljenko Lapaine (ICA 2019b). 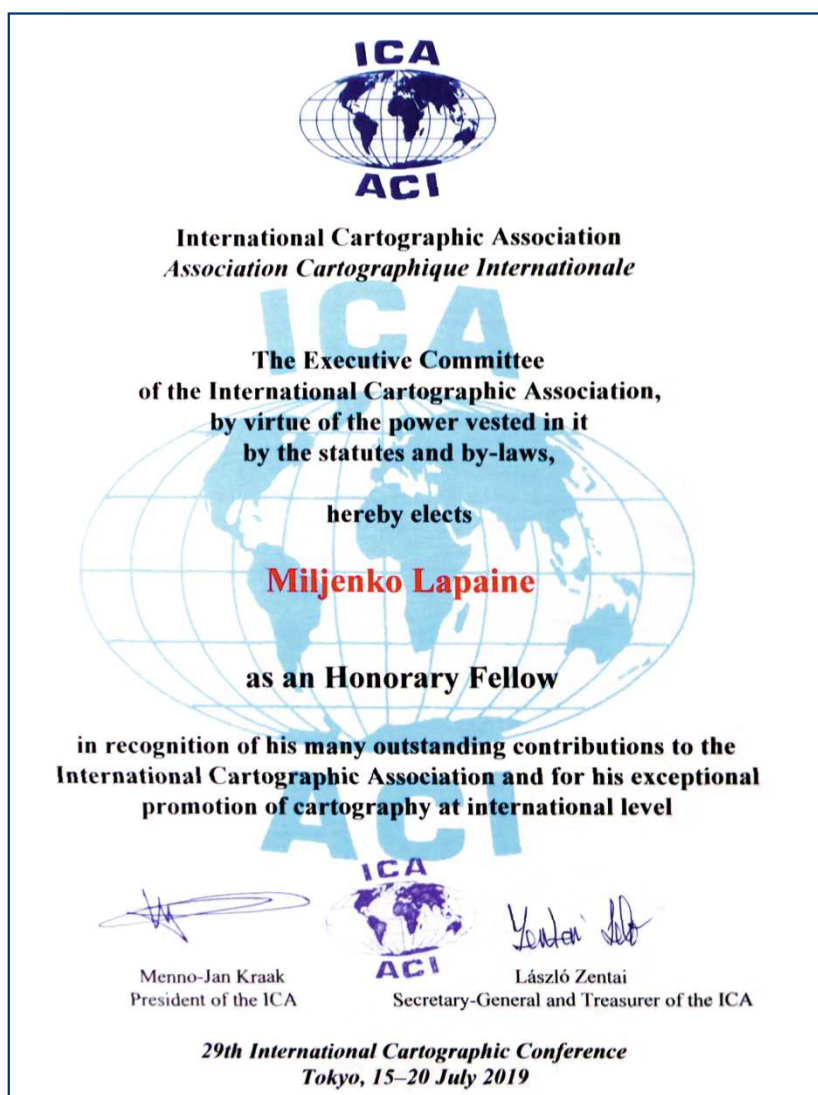
